7. **Pray for the Persecuted Church: CHINA| URGENT PRAYER NEEDED FOR DETAINED BELIEVER** Recently, Brother AK*, a Muslim-background believer (MBB) living in Northwest China, took his family to visit other MBBs in a neighbouring town. During the several-hour drive, they listened to the Bible using a USB device connected to their car. When they arrived at a checkpoint on the outskirts of the town, police officers discovered the USB and questioned Brother AK. He courageously admitted, "Because I believe in Jesus, I was listening to the Bible through the USB." With the family having several children, including a young baby, the police instructed AK's wife to take the children away while AK was detained for questioning. His wife and children were temporarily hosted by a Christian family in the small town while waiting his release. However, several days passed without any news of AK's whereabouts.
Please pray: Pray for Brother AK. May the Lord protect him, strengthen his faith, and grant his release soon. Pray for Brother AK's family. May God comfort the wife and children and give them strength. Pray for the Christian family who hosted Brother AK's wife and children. May God protect them and guide them with wisdom and courage. Pray for the local gatherings of Muslim-background believers. May God protect them and sustain their faith. Pray for the Open Doors' local partner, Jason, and others serving in the Muslim region. May God grant them wisdom, strength, and protection as they continue their work.
